President's Message

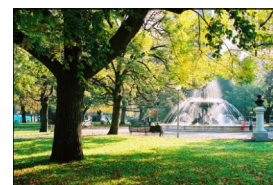
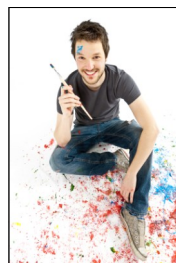
What are your resolutions for 2012??
